

SIMPLIFIED GUIDELINES FOR READING TRANSITS

There are six major aspects: the conjunction, sextile, square, trine, opposition, and parallel of declination. When reading transits, it is wise to include the inconjunct as well—the 150-degree aspect also known as the quincunx. It is a minor aspect that produces important effects in life. This text will cover the transiting conjunctions, parallels, oppositions, contra-parallels, squares, and trines of the outer planets.

Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto are seldom examined by progressed direction. Their progressed movement is so slow that they rarely form any aspects other than those already formed in the natal chart. But by transit they form important and revealing aspects to the natal planets. The duration of these aspects, with the exception of the parallel and contra-parallel, is four to six weeks on either side of the partile. However, Mars is only active for about two days on either side of the partile and acts more as a triggering device to release the astral forces.

The Fourteenth General Principle

When a transit aspect partiles at or near the new or full moon,
the aspect will be more forceful.

If a transiting planet forms an aspect near its station-point, its window of activity may open three times. This produces an intense period that can last off and on for three to four months. The active period will range from roughly one month in front of the first partile to one month after the last partile.

Pluto can change directions up to five times during a transit cycle and is active for up to two months on either side of the partile. Therefore, a Pluto transit can have a continually active period that lasts for as many as ten months. It can be active off and on for up to three years.

General Rules for Delineating Transiting Aspects

The average person finds the energy of the square and opposition very difficult to handle. Thus, astrologers consider them to be negative or hard aspects. But it is important to remember that without a square or two in the horoscope, a person cannot accomplish anything of importance in life because squares give the energy that is required. A square is stronger than an opposition. The inconjunct is hard but weaker.



The trine and sextile are considered positive or soft, which simply means the average person finds their energy easier to handle. The trine is stronger than the sextile. The conjunction and parallel of declination are the strongest aspects. They are equally strong, but a parallel is active for a much longer time. The planets involved will determine their positivity or negativity.

Transits should be delineated according to the following general rules:

- ◆ A transiting planet acts on the natal planet and its natal aspects if there are any.
- ◆ A transiting planet acts according to the aspect it forms with the natal planet but is heavily modified by natal aspects to that planet.
- ◆ If a natal planet is positive by aspect in the natal chart and the transit is positive, the areas and events will be positive.
- ◆ If a natal planet is negative by aspect in the natal chart and the transit is negative, the areas and events will be negative.
- ◆ If the natal planet is positive but the transit is negative, the events should be understood as not having a totally negative effect. There will be negativity because of the transit, but positivity will come out of that negativity because of the natal aspect.
- ◆ If the natal planet is negatively aspected but the transit is positive, natal events will override the force of the transit and not too much good can come from the positive transit.
- ◆ **Conjunctions** and parallels of declination are the most powerful aspects. Their positivity or negativity depends on the planets involved. The conjunction *empowers* or intensifies the planetary force it transits. It is a solar symbol.
- ◆ **Squares** are hard and bring strong disruptions into life if not handled skillfully. A square energizes the planetary force it activates. It is a Mars symbol.
- ◆ **Oppositions** and contra-parallels are hard aspects. They indicate two planetary energies opposing one another. If not handled skillfully, there will be a double loss. To be successful, you need to choose one pole of the opposition and not allow the other planetary force to interfere because of indecision or doubt. The opposition obstructs the natal planet. It is a lunar symbol.

- ◆ **Trines** manifest events and forces that produce what people call good luck. A trine expands the planetary energies involved in a transit. It is a Jupiter symbol.
- ◆ **Sextiles** represent events that will bring opportunity. However, there is no guarantee that a person will seize that opportunity. The sextile harmonizes the planetary energies involved in a transit. It is a Venus symbol.
- ◆ **Inconjuncts** exert stress on the natal planet. They indicate sickness and guilt. Some astrologers would say they indicate guilt, which produces stress, which produces sickness. It is a Saturn symbol.
- ◆ For better or worse, the **conjunction** allows the energy of the transiting planet to enter the natal planet.
- ◆ The **parallel** behaves and performs the same as the conjunction except it sustains its activity for a longer period of time.
- ◆ The **square** disrupts the natal planet with the force of the transiting planet.
- ◆ The **trine** harmonizes the transiting planet with the natal planet.
- ◆ The **sextile** brings an opportunity for the transiting planet to help the natal planet release its positivity.
- ◆ The **opposition** and contra-parallel obstruct the natal planet with the force of their transit.
- ◆ The **contra-parallel** behaves and performs the same as the opposition except it sustains its activity for a longer period of time.
- ◆ The **inconjunct** stresses the energy of the natal planet.

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THE PLUTO CONJUNCTIONS

Pluto symbolizes regeneration. It tells you when you have come to the end of a cycle in your life. It also indicates the transformation you will go through before entering the next cycle. These periods are often filled with spectacular events, intense stress, and not so subtle transformations. The full meaning of a Pluto transit is rarely grasped until it is over.

Pluto aspects involve large groups of people and secret or hidden events. A Pluto transit symbolizes a person or event that comes into your life bringing major transformation (for better or worse). The weaker aspects from Pluto reshape only a small section of your life whereas the major aspects reshape every arena of your life.

Pluto is a magnetic force-field in the unconscious mind. It relates to power and control, which we are drawn to when it activates the natal chart. The internal power of Pluto is released from the deep layers of the unconscious, inducing major changes in attitude that transform your life. Because it forces you to see what you prefer not to see, Pluto changes you forever. However, having seen how it affects your mind, you must now deal with it by either lifting the energy, incorporating it harmoniously into your life, or demagnetizing the mind from its attraction to power and control.

Pluto's underlying role is to produce a death and regeneration, to remove and renew. It symbolizes the end of something and its transformation. The ancient books talk about it being the symbol of death and rebirth. This can be misleading because people think only of physical death and not of the death of their ego or possessions.

It would be more accurate to say Pluto is the symbol of metamorphosis. A Pluto transit signals memorable transformations in the cycle of life. It represents a metamorphosis that produces a transformation. The positivity or negativity of the experience and the types of changes a person will go through are revealed by the study of seven basic factors.

These factors include the aspects to and from the natal Sun, its house position, and its rulership in the natal chart. The Sun is studied when delineating a transit because it symbolizes a person's egocentric point of view. Thus, it tells you how they are likely to experience the aspect. The seven factors that need to be considered are:

1. Aspects to the natal planet.
2. Aspects to natal Pluto.
3. The house of the natal planet.



4. The house of the natal Pluto.
5. The house ruled by the natal planet.
6. The house ruled by natal Pluto.
7. House position, aspects, and rulership of the natal Sun.

These seven points are the keys to predicting the effect of any transit. They can be reduced to three primary forces and three secondary forces:

1. The aspects of the natal planet.
2. The aspects of the transiting planet.
3. The aspects of the natal Sun.
 - a. The natal planet's house and rulership.
 - b. The transiting planet's natal house and rulership.
 - c. The natal Sun's house and rulership

Major transits exert an orb of influence on a natal planet for one degree on either side of the partile although their essential active period is twenty minutes on either side. Some planets fire early and others late, but twenty minutes of arc is the active period, and the partile the most active. Twenty minutes of arc is especially important when a planet is near a station-point, in which case it will override the standard one-month period. Though Pluto usually fires early and has an active period of twenty minutes of arc on either side of the aspect, my Guru still suggested using one month on either side of a Pluto partile.

PLUTO CONJUNCT THE ASCENDANT

The ascendant changes by one degree every four minutes. Thus, any aspect to the natal ascendant is meaningless unless you are sure the time of birth is accurate within a four-minute margin. Pluto has a one-degree orb of influence on either side of the ascendant. During this period, another transit from a faster moving planet (Moon, Mercury, Venus, Sun, or Mars) can cause this conjunction to fire.

The ascendant is the symbol of the personality, which is transformed by this transit, though not always for the better. These changes reveal negative qualities deep in the personality that are hard to look at and are socially speaking unacceptable. This results

in one's personal and business affairs undergoing major strain, which produces severe predicaments in one's life and mind.

Thoughts or events from the past that have been hidden from others are likely to be exposed during this conjunction. You will have to deal with this and your own personality as well. There will be a major shift in attitude, causing you to try to control everyone and everything (except your own mind). This attitude manifests because you feel that outside forces have taken control of your life or mind, which brings added problems all by itself. If natal aspects to the ascendant are hard, this transit can cause a person to believe they are being cursed or controlled by spirits.

PLUTO CONJUNCT THE SUN

Pluto over the Sun causes major events to manifest in one's life. It is a change-over cycle. Thus, something of the old must "die" to make way for the new. This transit increases your willpower and thus your drive to remake your life. But before this can happen, you have to balance your attachments and attitudes from the past.

You will become bolder, more enterprising, and try harder than ever before to achieve your goals under this aspect. Many astrologers say Pluto's energy cannot be easily controlled or channeled by a soul who has a strong ego. If you avoid the temptation to manipulate or restrain other people "for their own good," this conjunction will bring many subtle benefits. If you focus on improving your own personality, even greater benefits will manifest.

It is vital under this aspect to differentiate between what is essential in your life and what is nonessential. Then remove the nonessentials so you can move on with your life and evolution. You will fulfill outstanding dreams and goals or let them die. Be cautious of your reaction to subconscious memories that flow into your conscious mind at this time.

PLUTO CONJUNCT THE MOON

This transit produces intense emotional changes that can severely affect your home life. You will experience memories from childhood or a past-life. You are hypersensitive. Thus, dealings with your parents, family, and those closest to you will have an intense effect on your psychology and attitude. Guard your home and be careful during this transit. Burglary or mob action could cause major loss.

Because the Moon symbolizes women, they will have a powerful effect on your life. The positivity or negativity of this effect will depend on the lunar aspects in your natal



chart. The Moon also symbolizes the public, and you will have a great deal more contact with them during this cycle. Because the Moon symbolizes the home life, this conjunction suggests strong upheavals there that can bring about a change in your family composition.

PLUTO CONJUNCT MERCURY

The mind is deep, powerful, and determined. However, your external composure does not reveal it. This is a creative period for writing and lecturing. You want to increase the depth and breadth of your studies, including the study of health and healing. You will search for the meaning of life and your place in it. There is a need to communicate what you have discovered or think you have discovered.

You may come across information that is secret or classified. This may place a burden on you or put you in a difficult situation. Your willpower becomes strong and your self-awareness increases. This is the time to focus on the goal you have been pursuing for the last six lifetimes because it is likely to crystallize into your life during this incarnation. When it does, it will have a profound impact that will guide and control your life for the next twenty-two years. Therefore, be sure to reflect and meditate before focusing your mind on any given goal.

PLUTO CONJUNCT VENUS

This transit brings powerful romantic or sexual experiences and at the same time causes intense emotionality to enter your life. Keep them separate. In either event, these experiences will have a marked influence on you and your philosophy. Your social life will pick up during this cycle and you will gain many new friends.

Romance will lift you up or knock you down. It all depends on the natal aspects of Venus and Pluto. Powerful latent emotions may suddenly be released, showing you a side of your personality that you had not seen before. These thoughts and emotions have to be dealt with harmoniously. This conjunction produces added creativity and allows one's aptitudes to flow much more freely. There may be great loss or great gain. It all depends on the natal Venus and Pluto, which are the natural rulers of the second and eighth houses. There are five cautions that need to be exercised during this transit:

1. Be careful someone does not deceive you.
2. Be careful that you do not deceive others.



3. Be careful you do not deceive yourself.
4. Be clear about your values. They will be challenged through this aspect.
5. Watch your finances and be aware of money matters.

PLUTO CONJUNCT MARS

This aspect awakens and intensifies your willpower, causing you to become forceful. Although you may not see it, others will experience your actions as aggressive and self-assertive. Be wary of competitiveness and jealousy. Try to remain calm, and direct your energy into creative action. People become impulsive under this aspect. Fights and accidents happen suddenly and seemingly without cause. You have tremendous energy and can accomplish a great deal of work. But it is a dangerous time for dealing with fire and machinery, handling sharp tools, excessive exercise, and aggressive driving.

This conjunction intensifies one's sexual drive. Be aware and beware of accidents that can happen in this arena. They can be very serious. This aspect brings out unevolved personality traits that linger in the unconscious mind. Be careful. Do not harm another or cause them loss. This transit also brings you into contact with dishonest people. Be cautious so you do not fall under their influence. Be careful so you do not get burned. Be watchful so criminals do not cause you loss or harm.

PLUTO CONJUNCT JUPITER

Optimism and joy manifest through this transit. It is a time for education, travel, study, and gaining deeper insight into mystical philosophy. Your religious views are likely to change radically during this aspect. It is an excellent time to use your knowledge to help others through discussion, lecture, and publishing books and articles.

It is a tremendous time for improving your spiritual life and your financial life as well. Accomplishments that are important to you will manifest at this time. The deeper levels of the mind open and release more optimism and confidence than ever before. But if these two planets are afflicted in the natal chart, be careful of dealings with the courts or police because you could be taken in for questioning.

You will have a deep urge to seek out the mysteries of life and find answers. It is likely you will join organizations that you believe can help you in this quest. Marvelous mystical/religious experiences can manifest that will improve the rest of this incarnation. But be careful not to become a fundamentalist or a fanatic. Give others the room to think and believe as they wish.



PLUTO CONJUNCT SATURN

Saturn symbolizes resistance toward change or defiance. Pluto symbolizes unavoidable transformation. Thus, this is an exceptionally stressful period. Astrologers say Pluto's transformation is unavoidable because its force manifests from deep within the subconscious mind, which few people have access to or control over. In other words, the external changes that are seen at this time are the effect of intense psychological transformations that have left the subconscious level of the mind and manifested on the external plane. The fundamental order of your life is being regenerated. The house ruled by Saturn in the natal chart symbolizes this order.

This is a period when you gain power and feel it. However, circumstances in your life will repress your ambitions at this time. You will experience these restrictive conditions for a few months. Other people's beliefs and attitudes will cause you difficulty. If you wish to advance, it will be necessary for you to agree with your social group. The way you handle the conflicts that arise will set a precedent for your future security. You need to find new and improved methods for solving the internal and external problems of your life.

People undergo a severe testing of their values and beliefs during this transit. It can bring a sense of loneliness. Keep in mind that there is a difference between loneliness and aloneness. One negative expression of this conjunction is the possibility of losing money, possessions, or an important relationship. This can be softened by being careful and maintaining an attitude of skillful detachment.

Be cautious when making commitments during this aspect. They will be more binding than you want them to be. Some astrologers say this is not a period for success. I say it is a golden period for success if you work hard and learn to deal with impossible people and difficult conditions. If you can do that, you will gain tremendous success later in life, and it will be worth it.

PLUTO CONJUNCT URANUS

This transit produces massive and sudden conditions in life that are often called acts of God. These conditions bring about intense and unexpected changes in your life. They "rip out" one's present goals, which are then replaced with radically different goals. These radical changes most often manifest because of social upheavals caused by natural catastrophes, war, or revolution.

These conditions force you to seek answers, which you find through the study of astrology or other arcane sciences. Sometimes these forces cause you to become a reformer. This conjunction drives you to try to break free from conditions that are binding you or that you think are holding you back. If Uranus is heavily afflicted, you may feel self-righteous, that you know better than others what is best for them. This can lead to intense disagreements and violence.

PLUTO CONJUNCT NEPTUNE

This transit indicates a deep psychological transformation that causes major changes in a person's values, and thus their life goals. It is a time when you will closely question your most deeply held beliefs. This can cause disorientation if you become aware that parts of your life have only been a series of delusions. It is a time when many of the essentials in your life (or what you feel to be essentials) dissolve away. The dissolving of a job, situation, belief, or relationship is the result of intense psychological changes that are taking place. When this aspect is over, you will find it impossible to recognize your old self.

This transit brings strong mystical experiences, which cause you to seek out the ultimate answers to life. Past-life memories manifest and your dreams take on color and dimension. Your life often becomes total chaos, forcing you to find higher and subtler values to explain it. This conjunction releases unpleasant repressed experiences with which you will have to deal. You need to balance or resolve this energy if you want to return to a peaceful mystical state. It requires hard work to externalize your lifelong values at this time.

PLUTO CONJUNCT PLUTO

It takes 245 years for Pluto to transit around the entire chart and form a conjunction with itself. This cannot happen in the normal span of a human life. But if a person is born just before a Pluto station-point direct, the transiting Pluto will pass back over its natal position soon after the child is born. If this is the case, when it fires it will activate the natal Pluto and any aspects linked to it. If the natal Pluto has no aspects, its activation can be understood by an interpretation of the sign and house it is in and the house and quadrant it rules.



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THE NEPTUNE CONJUNCTIONS

When Neptune conjuncts a natal planet, the events ruled by that planet become idealized or confused. When Neptune forms a hard conjunction, it is an unfavorable period for making commitments related to events ruled by that planet. This is because you rarely have all the facts, and those you do have will be fuzzy or imprecise.

Neptune is vague and nebulous, yet it symbolizes spirituality and humanity's highest ideals. Because its energy is so subtle, it is hard to generalize about its manifestation. Much depends on an individual's horizon of awareness and values. In the artist or mystic, it can produce inspiration, a belief in higher goodness, or a call to serve all life forms. In a more practical person, it may simply bring an aspiration for concrete worldly rewards.

When it forms an aspect by transit, Neptune often produces confusion, vague fears, or illusion. Sometimes it brings mystery. But for most people it brings anxiety and deception, or much more often, self-deception. For many people, Neptune simply dissolves away their sense of reality, producing confusion and doubt. A hard aspect to Neptune actually makes it less vague. It helps one to see their faults more clearly and thus be able to correct them.

When Neptune touches a planet, the events ruled by that planet become either muddled or romanticized. Thus, Neptune either lifts you up or causes you to fall. It is slippery and insidious. When it conjuncts a planet, you can expect that planetary area to become idealized or confused. This will either produce fear, insecurity, and anxiety or revelation, inspiration and spiritual insight. You need to be very careful if a Neptune transit is linked by sign, house, or aspect to anything you value, for it can dissolve away in an almost indiscernible way.

To correctly interpret a Neptune transit, you need to carefully analyze the following factors:

1. How Neptune is aspected natively.
2. What aspects Neptune forms while transiting a house (if any).
3. How the natal planet is aspected.
4. How the ruler of the house Neptune is transiting is aspected.



These guidelines hold true for all transiting planets. The First Cosmic Law of Astrology states: *Only that which is contained in the natal horoscope can manifest as the horoscope moves through time.*

The horizon of one's awareness is always the final factor in determining the events that will manifest and how they manifest. The outcome of any planetary force is mostly determined by a person's spirituality. This was explained in the Third and Fourth Cosmic Laws of Astrology, which state: *Character is destiny! Thus, aspects that correspond to the disposition and temperament of your personality will take priority over aspects that do not correspond to your temperament.* Once again, this emphasizes the need to examine the natal horoscope and thoroughly understand the temperament and predisposition of your mind-body complex.

My Guru suggested using five weeks on either side of a Neptune partile. During this period, Neptune's energy will manifest in subtle and diffused ways.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT THE ASCENDANT

The ascendant is your horizon of awareness. Neptune is nebulous and confusing. Be cautious — its effect on the ascendant will be subtle and difficult to perceive. What you are more likely to notice is the house ruled by Neptune. It becomes a source of concern during this transit because you tend to lose control of it. Important elements in this area of your life begin to dissolve away unless you can stop it. This requires concentration, hard work, and the ability to always keep one foot firmly on the ground.

If the ruler of the fifth and ninth house are well aspected natively and Neptune is favorable, this is a superb time for spiritual development. Dream states will open into the astral realm, bringing direct experiences of the inner world.

The negative forces involved in this conjunction are twofold. First you are vulnerable to fraud and deception because you are blind to other people's shortcomings or true motives. But far more dangerous, your mind is especially susceptible at this time to any suggestion given by another. Therefore, you want to stay away from people who are manipulative or verbally abusive and destructive. You also want to avoid negative people and situations, including violent movies and television.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT THE SUN

This aspect brings difficulties with superiors and people in authority like a parent, spouse, boss, or government agent. If the Sun is afflicted natively, there is danger of

injury to your reputation. But if the Sun is well aspected, little danger will occur. Your health may suffer because of exhaustion or a bad case of nerves. When Neptune forms a hard transit to the natal Sun, it produces insecurity which, in turn, creates anxiety and fear. This leads to poor decision-making.

On the positive side, this conjunction will intensify your intuition and sensitivity, awakening a greater sense of compassion. If your personality has been chiefly materialistic up to now, under the influence of this conjunction you will shift your awareness toward esoteric studies and seek the supreme meaning of life. This occurs because the Sun symbolizes your will, and Neptune at its highest level symbolizes those states of consciousness transcendent of the ego-self.

Because you are unaccustomed to using energy from the deeper levels of your being, you will most likely experience exhaustion. Do not make unnecessary or extreme demands on your mind-body complex because it can cause your body to become sick. This transit will make you idealistic. Do not become naïve. Be sure that realism rules.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT THE MOON

This transit produces change in the home environment, personal life, and intimate affairs. It is a magic moment to study your dreams and your dream states. This fundamental aspect opens the “feelers” of your mind so your mind becomes supersensitive, either positively or negatively. It can also cause you to become psychic by releasing your underlying extrasensory abilities. The direction the mind takes will depend on the natal chart.

This aspect can produce anxiety, misgivings, and restlessness. Difficulties can arise because of, or through, women, mother, wife, or children. The stomach and digestion may experience problems or illness related to fluid imbalances. If you have any past addictions, be vigilant. They will tend to manifest again at this time. Watch the water you drink. It may not be as pure as you think. Beware of swimming. Neptune over the Moon also produces a change in one’s residence or a wish to travel.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT MERCURY

Neptune conjunct Mercury brings changes of opinion and habit. Difficulties often occur through careless speech or writing. There is a deep and subtle conflict with this conjunction. Mercury symbolizes hard logic whereas Neptune symbolizes higher intuition, which the average mind cannot grasp. When they come together, they produce



elusiveness and lack of clarity or vagueness. Thus, this conjunction produces the likelihood of being deceived, or deceiving oneself. Sometimes people are tempted to deceive others.

Business complications can also occur. Watch your associates. They may have a bad influence on you. Troubles may arise through documents, studying, brethren, and neighbors. Excessive traveling or commuting takes place. If both natal planets are positive by aspect, you might find that although your logic is poor, your intuition is very good.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT VENUS

This is a wonderful, positive, and powerful aspect for creative people. Even if you are not creative, this conjunction will cause the beauty of the arts to flow into your life and become part of you. It brings gain or advantage through friendships, social pleasures, and love affairs. It is one of the most favorable transits for bringing romance and love into your life. This love can be real but can just as easily be illusory. It is usually directed toward a person but could just as easily be directed toward a place or idea.

When Neptune and Venus are natively afflicted, loss, anxiety, and disappointments can occur. This aspect symbolizes frustration through self-deception, especially in love and financial matters. If disappointments occur in love, they are often caused by your delusion about who the person is or what you feel the person should be. This aspect can also make you respond to people or causes with total selflessness. This may be positive, but please keep one foot on the ground. Love should not make you unrealistic or impractical. It should help you see yourself and others more clearly.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT MARS

This aspect brings accidents, quarrels, disputes, and health problems, such as infection and fever. These cause your energy levels to be easily drained. This can lead to discouragement and ineffective action, which can cause heavy expenses to occur. Your physical health also needs to be watched. It is oversensitive and thus easily poisoned by alcohol, drugs, pharmaceuticals, and bad food, especially seafood and beef.

Neptune produces insecurity when it makes a hard transit to the natal Mars. This creates anxiety and fear, often leading to poor decisions. You need to guard against unclear, reckless, or "shady" actions that can cause legal complications or problems in other areas of your life.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT JUPITER

This transit brings success and prosperity in or through the law and religion. If well aspected, it brings about increased social advantages, new friends, pleasures, and the fulfillment of one's dreams and hopes. If both are natively afflicted, it brings loss through religion and legal affairs.

The conjunction of these two planets brings restlessness and an urge to travel long distances. For some people, it produces an urge to explore and understand different cultures or the religious experience. The biggest danger of this aspect is that you can easily believe that anything you do will work out well. If you are not careful, this erroneous thought will get you into serious trouble.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT SATURN

From a mystical point of view, this is a great spiritual aspect. The reason for this is Saturn crystallizes your errors and faults, enabling you to see them clearly and thus correct them. However, on the earth plane this aspect brings a loss of self-assurance and therefore induces fear. This transit brings problems in one's occupation or through governments that produce reversals. There will be a tendency toward loss and discredit. This can lead to depression, or is it depression that leads to the loss?

On a psychological level, this aspect indicates that the perceived structure of your self-created world is changing. This produces disorientation and disorganization. Therefore, take more time before making decisions. The problem that is under this aspect you will be working against the clock. In other words, time pressures will force you to make a decision.

When Neptune forms a hard transit to the natal Saturn, the aspect causes insecurity, which creates anxiety and fear. If both planets and the ruler of the sixth house are natively afflicted, the most serious danger from this aspect is that one could develop a slow progressive illness that is difficult or impossible to diagnose. Check the natal aspects to both planets and the ruler of the sixth house for indications of potential problems.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT URANUS

This transit indicates confusion or irresponsibility related to the house where the conjunction occurs and the house Uranus rules. It brings difficulties through electricity and electronic gadgets. Well aspected, it can drive one toward prominence or power. It also drives people to explore the occult or astrology. If negatively aspected, there will be a failure to fulfill one's dreams and goals. Trouble can also arise because of radioactive materials or x-rays.



Your friends may deceive you or someone may deceive them. If new friends have bad habits, get away from them immediately and stay away. Some of the people you meet now will be from your past. You and they have negative past-life karma related to deception, drugs, and dissipation. If you are not careful, they will be the bringers of your karma and cause confinement.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT NEPTUNE

This aspect can only occur if Neptune is near a station-point at the time of birth. If the conjunction does occur, the life will be marked with the meaning of the Neptune by house, sign, and most of all its natal aspects. If the Neptune is positive, it will bring inspiration from poetry, music, or other facets of culture. It often produces spiritual experiences. If the Neptune is negative, the person may suffer from feelings of confinement, loss of self-worth, or deep-seated feelings of loneliness. Dreams and negative psychic experiences can also manifest.

NEPTUNE CONJUNCT PLUTO

This conjunction has not happened since the late 19th century. It is unlikely that this aspect will occur in your lifetime. If it does, the transiting Neptune over Pluto produces a similar effect as transiting Neptune over Mars except events with Pluto will manifest several times and will involve many people.

THE URANUS CONJUNCTIONS

Uranus is a symbol of extreme change. It manifests suddenly and in unexpected ways. It fires early and is difficult to predict accurately. It is always a surprise, producing experiences that are not part of your daily life. It is a chapter-maker, closing off one chapter of your life and opening a new one. The negativity of a Uranus transit has to do with a person's unwillingness to accept change because they are partial to regularity and reliability.

Uranus conjunctions always bring about an urge to be free. For most people, this means doing what they want what to do when they want to do it and how they want to do it. This can be a very selfish attitude or it can be revolutionary. Uranus is the only planetary force that can break the limits of Saturn. Uranus is a thunderbolt. Some astrologers call it the awakener because its energies awaken you to see how to remove the limitations of this incarnation. Uranus gives you the opportunity to break free from Saturn limitation, but its effect can be unexpectedly disruptive. Sri Shelliji often said, "The power of Uranus is unpredictable in the way in which it will manifest. Thus, expect the unexpected." He suggested using one month on either side of the partile.

URANUS CONJUNCT THE ASCENDANT

Your mind will be focused on winning liberation or at least freedom from all outer and inner pressures. This is good, but there is a danger that you will become irritated with people and situations, and intolerant. The people around you will see you as unstable, and thus untrustworthy. Unlike Neptune's transit of the ascendant, the area of your life you feel to be most affected by all this is the first house of your personality.

Unlike Neptune, which is vague and hard to see, a Uranus transit cannot be missed, especially when it conjuncts the ascendant. The changes that take place during this aspect are caused by a shift in your personality, but they are directly related to the natal house position of Uranus and its natal house rulership. Uranus brings disruption. The clashes that arise will be between these houses and your new personality.

This transit is valuable for breaking out of restrictive personal or professional relationships and seeking new and freer ones. On a mystical level, it is one of the key aspects for gaining liberation — freedom from your mind's emotions, attachments, and delusions. Many people seek advancement through the study of the esoteric sciences, which includes astrology.



URANUS CONJUNCT THE SUN

This transit produces a personality that is strong and assertive, and that has a good deal of willpower. The personality will insist, for better or worse, on more freedom and self-expression. The younger you are when this aspect fires, the more defiant and disobedient you will become.

You will be forced by external events to change and break away from old established patterns of living. You will seek out new and uncustomary experiences. You will be magnetic and creative, which attracts a new group of friends who will be eccentric to say the least. Because the Sun symbolizes the heart and Uranus symbolizes interruption of that which is normal, this is a time to be careful of not overstraining your heart.

URANUS CONJUNCT THE MOON

This conjunction causes many sudden, abrupt, and unexpected changes to come into your life. These changes occur in the home environment and with the public and women or children. You will be restless and feel the need to make changes. When you do, stay away from extremes. Most people have a difficult time managing this aspect because it produces astonishing and unexpected events. There can also be problems with, and because of, electricity or electronic equipment.

The Moon symbolizes your intimate temperament and habit patterns. Uranus symbolizes major upheavals. Thus, this conjunction can bring about deep, intense psychological disorders and emotional upheavals. Depending on the natal aspects of these two planets, it can also cause sudden gain or loss in your business life. Pay close attention to your intuition. It can help steer you through these turbulent times.

URANUS CONJUNCT MERCURY

This aspect influences your mind to study and explore the unusual or exotic, as well as the occult, astrology, and reincarnation. The mind has many original ideas, but most of them are unfeasible now. Your health and diet need to be watched because you may be nervous or irritated. Emotions can cause you to change your job or get you dismissed. Independent of everything else, this conjunction causes the pace of your mind to become way too fast. This can lead to psychological disorders associated with nervousness and anxiety.

Your intuition is stronger than usual, but it may not be practical in your everyday life. Difficulty with communications, especially with telephones, computers, and faxes can manifest. Short journeys can be a problem, as delays and unanticipated events may occur while traveling. If both planets are afflicted natively, accidents can also occur. For some people, this would be a good time to develop automatic writing. Though for some, it just happens.

URANUS CONJUNCT VENUS

This transit brings powerful and unexpected romantic relationships. They usually start suddenly and break off just as abruptly. Money matters need to be watched. There can be loss or gain, depending on the natal aspects of the two planets. This conjunction can bring some exciting and spectacular events into your life. Pay close attention to the house where Venus is found in the natal chart and the houses it rules. One of these will be where the action manifests.

You will most likely seek greater excitement and freedom, especially in love relationships. Your attitude toward money, love, sex, and social values will become revolutionary. Electronic toys hold a fascination, as does the opposite sex. In the creative field, your mind will be flooded with new ideas and creations.

URANUS CONJUNCT MARS

This is a potentially dangerous aspect that can lead to serious accidents and problems. These accidents, if they happen, are sudden, unexpected, and involve cars, machinery, electricity, or fire. Sometimes they involve x-rays or radioactive material. There can be strong emotional explosions that lead to violence. Both Uranus and Mars symbolize power forces, and when they get together, they cannot be ignored. Therefore, they must be properly channeled.

Conditions in your life that you have tolerated for years will most likely become unbearable now. This causes you to explode, markedly changing your life for better or worse. There is a strong need for independence that results in rash actions. These actions will affect your love life and business relationships. You will experience an increase in energy, personal magnetism, and ego drive, which often leads to people making sudden changes in their life.



URANUS CONJUNCT JUPITER

This conjunction causes you to become more philosophical. Advantages come from new friendships and organizations, presenting opportunities to travel and further your education. The mind is sensitive and intuitive. Important dreams arise. An increased philosophical mood causes you to delve deeper into life through the study of metaphysics, the occult, astrology, or Eastern philosophy. Nonetheless, you will also become extravagant, careless, and reckless.

Sudden benefits come to you in the form of financial gain or a new job. This financial fortune may enter your life through inheritance, insurance, or taxes. All of this is the result of sudden or unexpected events that open up new and greater possibilities for a better life. My Guru and my mother often reminded me of the adage, "If it comes too easily, it leaves too quickly." My Guru said this aspect opens doors that close quickly. Therefore, know what you want out of life before you enter this aspect so you can quickly jump through the door of opportunity before it closes.

URANUS CONJUNCT SATURN

You will take on increased responsibilities under this transit. It is a time when you will make ideas (yours or others) practical. There is a tendency to introduce new methods and new technology into your life. There is often a change in job or career. Sometimes changes manifest in your personal life as well.

This is a powerful and disruptive aspect because the two planets are about as far apart as two planetary forces can get. Thus, there is an acute struggle in your soul. The more fixed your ideas of personal stability, the greater will be the shock of this aspect. Circumstances, relationships, and events that you believe are in your life to stay are likely to be challenged.

URANUS CONJUNCT URANUS

When a transiting planet comes back to its natal position, it is called its return. The Uranus return normally occurs around the age of eighty-four. However, it can also occur early in life if Uranus was close to a station-point near the time of birth. When this is the case, Uranus can change direction and transit back over itself when a person is quite young. If the return occurs because Uranus goes retrograde early in life, it means that one's life will be markedly disrupted. It indicates that the childhood environment may lose its tranquility and serenity.

If Uranus conjuncts itself after it has circled the chart, you will be in your eighties. The changes that occur release you from petty everyday obligations. Depending on the natal aspects, this conjunction can seriously disrupt the house in which Uranus is found and the house it rules. Marked changes occur related to your home environment and the house ruled by Uranus. New friends come into your life and stimulate your intellectual soul. The next phase of your evolution and how it will manifest are symbolized by what happens when this aspect activates in your eighties.

URANUS CONJUNCT NEPTUNE

This conjunction is one of the most extraordinary you will ever go through. It causes you to experience not only new levels of consciousness but also different states of consciousness. Like most Uranus aspects, it can lift you up or cause you to fall.

This transit causes new powerful ideas to affect your life. They will be subtle yet very intense. These ideas will be revolutionary but can have a negative side effect, drawing off your energy and producing fatigue. There will be a change in your consciousness. It can produce a more highly evolved consciousness — attuned to art, philosophy, and religion. Alternatively, it can produce a fall in consciousness, causing addiction to ideas like power and enslavement or substances like alcohol, drugs, and sugar.

URANUS CONJUNCT PLUTO

This transit sweeps away all the old structures in your life, bringing new attitudes and new patterns of thinking and behavior. Because Pluto is a symbol of group karma, you will feel whatever most people of your generation are feeling. Thus, it brings drastic social changes with fiscal consequences. It induces an insight into what is wrong with your life, which should awaken a realization of the changes you need to make.

This aspect often leads to a deeper and clearer understanding of your inner life. It brings new and radically different conditions to which you must adapt. It would be wise to have an attitude of flexibility and flow wisely with the forces that manifest. Otherwise they will overthrow the part of your life that has been of greatest value to you. People often become deeply involved in a study of the occult in order to recognize the new thoughts and ideals they need in order to transform their lives under this transit. Be mindful of health related problems that can arise.

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THE SATURN CONJUNCTIONS

Saturn is the key planet to watch by transit. It symbolizes how you perceive the world you have created (in your mind). This perceived encounter is all-important to understand. It causes you to act or react to that world in a fixed, rigid way, which to a greater or lesser degree, controls and determines your limitations in life. Thus, Saturn symbolizes your essential karma. Understanding this idea is vital to understanding freedom, free will, and the great mystery of Life.

Saturn symbolizes Chronos — Father Time, the keeper of the cosmic clock that chimes and dispenses karma at the appointed hour. Part of your life should always be dedicated to neutralizing these forthcoming karmic events, to softening as much of that karma as possible before it manifests.

When Saturn transits a natal planet, be aware of the house the planet rules and the house it is in. If the aspect is soft, Saturn will benefit and strengthen the events ruled by those houses. If the aspect is hard, it points out that you need to pay more attention to the events symbolized by those houses. This is the science of mysticism, which works hand-in-hand with the art of yoga, offering you the tools to balance your life and move forward in your evolution.

Saturn is a symbol of work, effort, and striving. It is also a symbol of responsibility and karma. If you gain insight into your spiritual responsibilities, you are well on your way to solving and softening the karma of this incarnation. Remember, it is your responsibility, as **you** see it, not what someone else tells you. My beloved mother comes to mind. She often said to me, "Kriyananda, the greater a person's ability, the greater is that person's responsibility." My Guru often said, "Kriyanandaji, if a person does not choose self-discipline, discipline will be karmically forced on him."

The transits of Saturn bring hard work and responsibility into one's life. If these are not seen as an opportunity, a blessing, and a joy, it brings about disappointments and depression. Saturn brings order and stability into people's lives, which they often see as dullness. For most people, Saturn restrains pleasure by imposing limits. It is known as the Dark Teacher, and its key lesson is to teach us that we only get that which we have earned through our own hard work and effort.



Saturn usually retrogrades over the first few degrees and last few degrees of each sign. Any natal planets found in these degrees will be markedly affected because the transiting Saturn will conjunct them three times. Watch the events of the first and second transit. If the second is stronger than the first, the third will be even stronger. If the second is weaker than the first, the third will usually be weaker still.

The Tenth Cosmic Law of Astrology

Whatever manifests under a transit of Saturn tends to become permanent for this lifetime and perchance beyond. Thus, great care and self-awareness need to be applied to all transits of Saturn to ensure that the difficulties that arise under hard aspects do not become permanent.

Events that occur under a Saturn transit are usually permanent. It tends to fire late, or you realize what has happened long after the partile. This is especially true of Saturn's transit of the Sun. My Guru suggested using six weeks on either side of a Saturn partile as the active period.

SATURN CONJUNCT THE ASCENDANT

Saturn is the key symbol of a person's karma. Therefore this conjunction, which occurs at least twice in most people's lives, is one of the key transits. It is a period during which you feel confined or are confined. One of the reasons for this feeling of confinement is the large quantity of work and responsibilities you will accumulate. Any job or task you attempt at this time will take much longer than usual and require much more effort to complete. When looking back on this cycle, most people say it was one of the hardest periods of their life but one of the most productive.

You will not be flexible. Thus, you will find it hard to adjust, adapt, and acclimatize. You will be ambitious, work hard, and want to succeed. Remember that this is the time for work, not for promotion. That will come later. The area that will cause you the most confinement, other than your personality, is the house ruled by Saturn.

People often try to simplify their lives under this aspect. One danger that I have seen repeatedly is that people want to give everything away or sell it for far less than it is worth. Be aware of this, and hold onto your assets. There is also a tendency to lose weight.



SATURN CONJUNCT THE SUN

This transit occurs every twenty-nine and a half years. It causes delays with almost everything in your life. Events slow down and obstacles manifest. It is always a difficult and trying time, but fantastic benefits and accomplishments can manifest from your efforts. Saturn inhibits the vitality of the Sun, causing you to be tired or exhausted. This inhibiting of energy compels your consciousness into areas that need to be mastered for your spiritual evolution. The problem is this loss of vitality also makes you lose interest, and you can become fearful, cautious, and filled with doubt.

The secret to understanding whether positivity or negativity will arise through this aspect is revealed by what happened in your life a little over fourteen years ago (when Saturn opposed the Sun). The choices you made at that time and the way you dealt with those harsh conditions and difficulties will control the outcome of this cycle. Saying it another way, your actions over the last fourteen years in the garden of your life are now reaching a point of maturity, reaping either sweet or sour grapes. The areas of your life in which you have worked skillfully and successfully will yield positive outcomes. Those areas that have not been handled skillfully or successfully will meet major obstacles. This will redirect your life so you can learn the lessons your soul needs in order to further evolve spiritually.

Problems will arise with authoritarian figures and sometimes with government agencies. This aspect also brings the frustration of your goals, dreams, and ambitions. There can be problems with older people. These events can lead to a loss of position or reputation. Thus, it is an unfortunate time to undertake added assignments or responsibilities.

SATURN CONJUNCT THE MOON

This configuration causes a restriction of the emotions, which produces major problems with the family, women, children, and the public. Lack of vitality, dehydration, and sluggish digestion can manifest. It is a difficult time for any type of public relations. Business and personal relationships that are strained or broken will be hard to put back together. This transit often brings depression, which leads to self-pity and loneliness. It is a time for introspection, to see what is wrong or malfunctioning in your mind-computer and to correct or repair it. However, you need to be careful that introspection does not give way to becoming overly self-critical.



The emotional constriction that occurs at this time can manifest as being jaded, excessively critical of self and others, or being emotionally frozen. The prime emotion is often guilt, which causes negative thoughts and produces self-destructive action. The upshot of this negative emotionality is that you will pull away from everyone, including yourself. Others will feel you are insensitive to their needs and feelings.

This conjunction can be one of the most helpful or hindering transits in the chart because of a dynamic that is known as chasing the moon. It occurs because the Moon takes twenty-eight years to pass through the entire zodiac by progression whereas Saturn takes twenty-nine and one half years by transit. Thus, the transiting Saturn and the progressed Moon stay in essentially the same aspect for decades, if not for a lifetime, and they produce one of the most powerful Saturn effects in the chart.

If there is a natal conjunction, square, or opposition between Saturn and the Moon, it will tend to activate consistently throughout one's life. Conversely, if Saturn and the Moon are in sextile or trine at birth, these positive aspects will be a consistent force over this incarnation. The significant areas to look at are the houses ruled by the Moon and Saturn and the house where the Moon is found natively.

SATURN CONJUNCT MERCURY

Saturn over Mercury brings worry, anxiety, and a pessimistic, restrictive attitude, but it is a great time for serious study. Working hard during this transit with the right attitude will bring major rewards later. The problem is that one can become too introverted and serious. Be careful of ignoring people and their needs. Whatever you do, communicate, communicate, communicate! To communicate will bring problems, but not to communicate will bring even greater problems.

Your thinking becomes negative, pessimistic and discontented. It narrows down to a few thoughts or concepts, most of which are secondary to your life and goals. Because of this narrow point of view, you fail to see the great opportunities in your life or alternative solutions to your present problems. Important communications are sometimes lost, delayed, or do not happen at all under this aspect, often causing business problems. There can be difficulties and delays while traveling. It is a time to focus on serious hard work.

It feels like life crowds you in, causing feelings of confinement. The work area and home tend to feel dark, damp, or depressive. Family members often have major problems. There is danger of making a mistake by signing (or not signing) documents, which

leads to other problems. Watch your diet and your health. Problems can arise with the nervous system, affecting your hearing or speech. Be careful of getting burned out.

SATURN CONJUNCT VENUS

This aspect will test the best of relationships. Only those that are strong will survive. It brings involvements with older people on a personal or business level. There may be difficulties in your life because of what they perceive to be aloofness or your reserved attitude and outlook. This causes you to feel lonely. Thus, you strive to find a deeper friendship, often successfully (but with heavy attachments).

You will gain what you want from a relationship during this cycle. However, keep in mind that you will remain when the aspect has passed. Ask yourself who and what you want thirty years from now. When the aspect does pass, you will wonder whether the relationship is what you wanted or needed. In either case the attachment is not easy to dissolve.

This is an excellent period to reflect and wisely restructure your future. When the aspect passes, look at the restructuring plan you came up with and modify it. This plan will have the best of the positive and only a little of the negative. One effect of this transit that some consider positive is your taste for sugar products is diminished. Therefore, you lose weight.

SATURN CONJUNCT MARS

This transit produces hard and dirty work. The home or work area becomes noisy and dirty. Emotions often explode because of fear, anger, or carelessness. Frustration is the key emotion, mostly in the form of irritability. This causes you to react viciously to even the smallest events. You are critical and abusive in your actions and facial expressions. Beware. Cool down, or you will pay a heavy price. If you have a volatile temperament by nature, this could be a grim period for you or someone else in your life.

There are often problems with criminals or the police. You need to guard against accidents in the home or car. Health problems, including fevers, and problems with bones need to be watched. If you have rheumatism or arthritis or a proclivity toward them, this could be a painful period. Strong desires and intense ambitions can lead to harshness and ruthlessness. Other people may attack you without apparent provocation, but if you observe your thought patterns, you will understand why.



SATURN CONJUNCT JUPITER

This transit produces a conflict between the wish to expand and the fear of expansion. Thus, there is a scrutiny of long-range goals and their value. There is often a need to become more prudent and practical in business activity, which brings about added responsibility. There are three changes that are likely to occur during this aspect: a change in your occupation, a change in your home, and most likely a change in your finances. This is a favorable period for professional people and for business, but stress caused by the battle between expansiveness and practicality can lead to critical conditions that affect reputation and position.

SATURN CONJUNCT SATURN

This is one of the most important cycles of your life. The house where Saturn is found natively and the house it rules are about to experience one of the most critical periods of your life. Whether this conjunction is positive or negative largely depends on whether or not the natal Saturn is favorably aspected. If the natal Saturn is negative, the conjunction will be stressful, to say the least. If positive, it will only be difficult, causing you to be emotional. Either way, there will be delays and a need for patience and hard work.

Circumstances and events in your life that you have tolerated in the past will no longer be acceptable. Thus, major changes occur, bringing an end to relationships or partnerships linked to the situations that have become unacceptable. Regardless of the aspects to your natal Saturn, whatever happens at this time, you will become far more mature through what you experience.

This conjunction occurs when you are in your late twenties and again in your late fifties or early sixties. Each of these cycles tells you whether the previous fifteen years of your life were skillfully lived and if the lessons were learned. Thus, this transit can be difficult and bring loss or it can bring great rewards and compensation.

The effort and stress that occur will manifest in the house where the conjunction takes place. This is the area of your life where you need to apply self-discipline, maturity, patience, and caution. Symbolically, this aspect is a sketch of your karma. It tells you how strong and how positive the storage tank of your karma has become.

SATURN CONJUNCT URANUS

This is an excellent time to make practical use of inspirational and intuitive ideas. This conjunction brings a period during which you can break free from your past karma. There are strong inner emotions in the mind that want to break free from all limitation. This is good, but be cautious. There is danger of going to extremes when trying to break free.

You may feel you have lost your freedom or that personal and business conditions limit you. Your reaction to this can cause career changes or loss. This conjunction symbolizes powerful subconscious energies crashing into each other. Uranus is an unconscious force wishing to produce change. Saturn relates to the force of resistance. The house ruled by Saturn clashes with the house ruled by Uranus, a symbolic struggle between the 11th house and 10th house.

On one level, it should be clear that your career ambitions and your personal goals are in conflict with each other, but whatever action you take will surprise your friends as well as your boss. If the energy of Uranus is blocked too extensively or for too long, you will find that you explode and make radical changes in your job, career, or personal and private life.

There is always an increase of responsibility under Saturn and thus added restrictions in your life. Difficulties can occur related to land, buildings, and electronic equipment. You will most likely be forced to make changes. If you are, be sure that they are made at an indispensable level.

SATURN CONJUNCT NEPTUNE

This is a good time for spiritual study if Neptune is natively well aspected because progress will reveal mystical experiences. This transit improves your personality. Thus, you become more grounded and practical. Rarefied ideas become functional. There is creative activity that wants to express itself as art, music, painting, or writing.

Your own moods (or other people's) may be negative or pessimistic. You must learn to live patiently with them. They must be handled on the inner planes. If Neptune is afflicted in the natal chart, there is danger of negative psychological experiences. Thus, one needs to be cautious of vague emotions and unrealistic ideas.



SATURN CONJUNCT PLUTO

The mind becomes more concentrated and focused on the attainment or use of power. Thus, problems may arise because of pressure and attempted manipulation of people. Sometimes they try to manipulate you. Sometimes it is the other way around. This conjunction produces a shortage of means for getting the job done. It symbolizes the end of an old cycle and the beginning of a new multi-incarnational cycle. Though most people will experience this conjunction two or three times, it is the first conjunction of each lifetime that sets the pattern. Your work, responsibilities, and actions will have far reaching results.

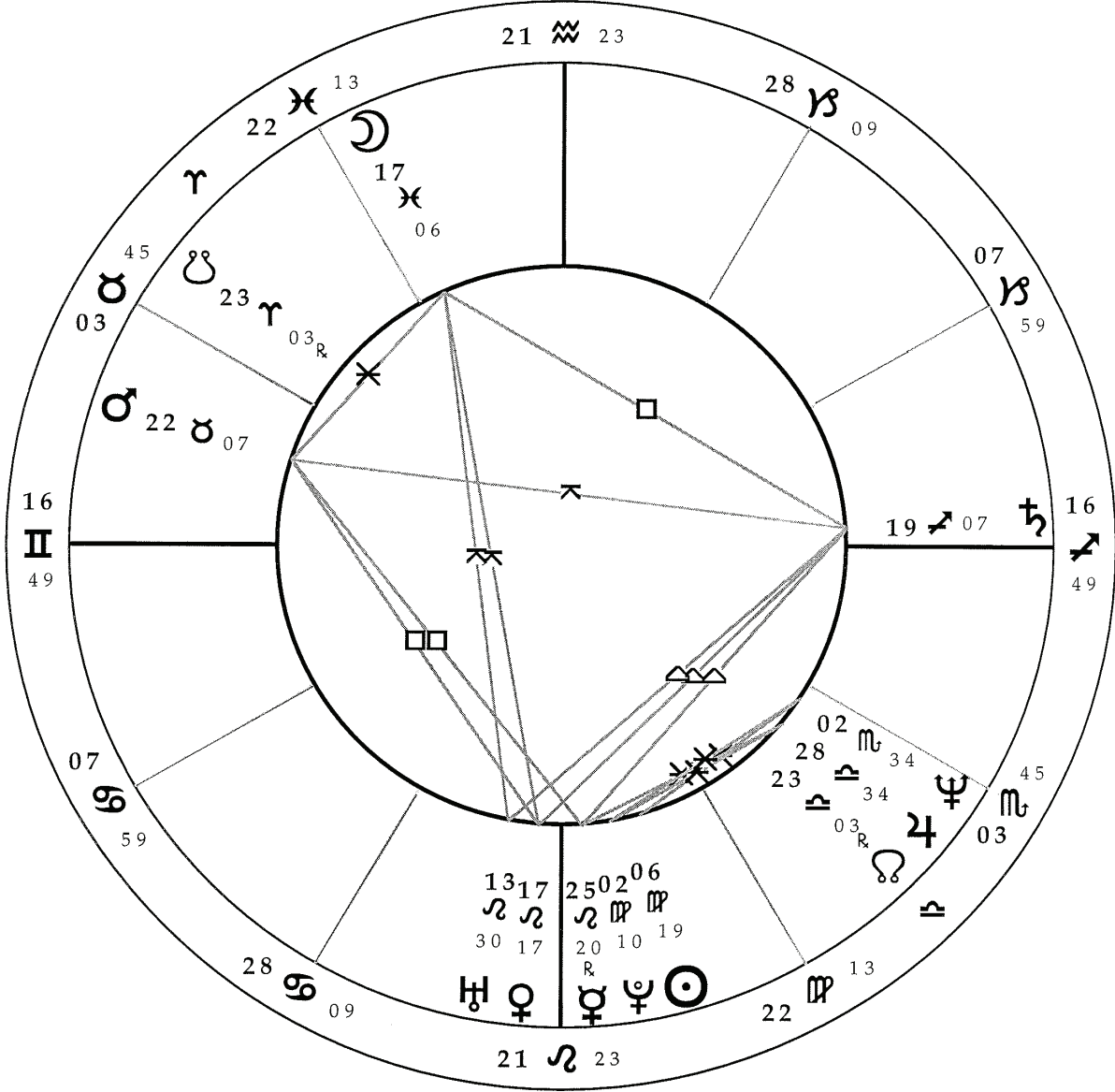

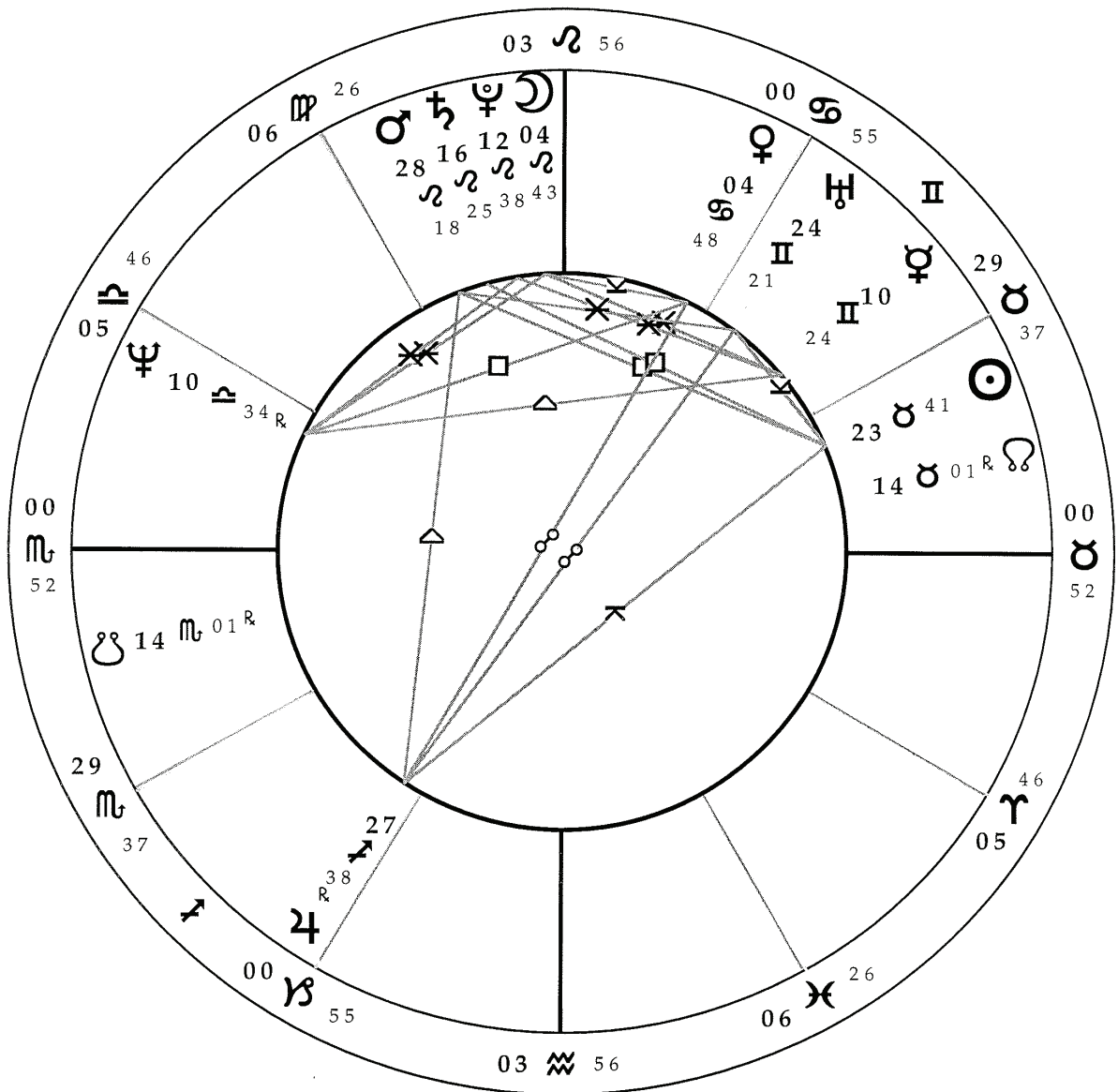
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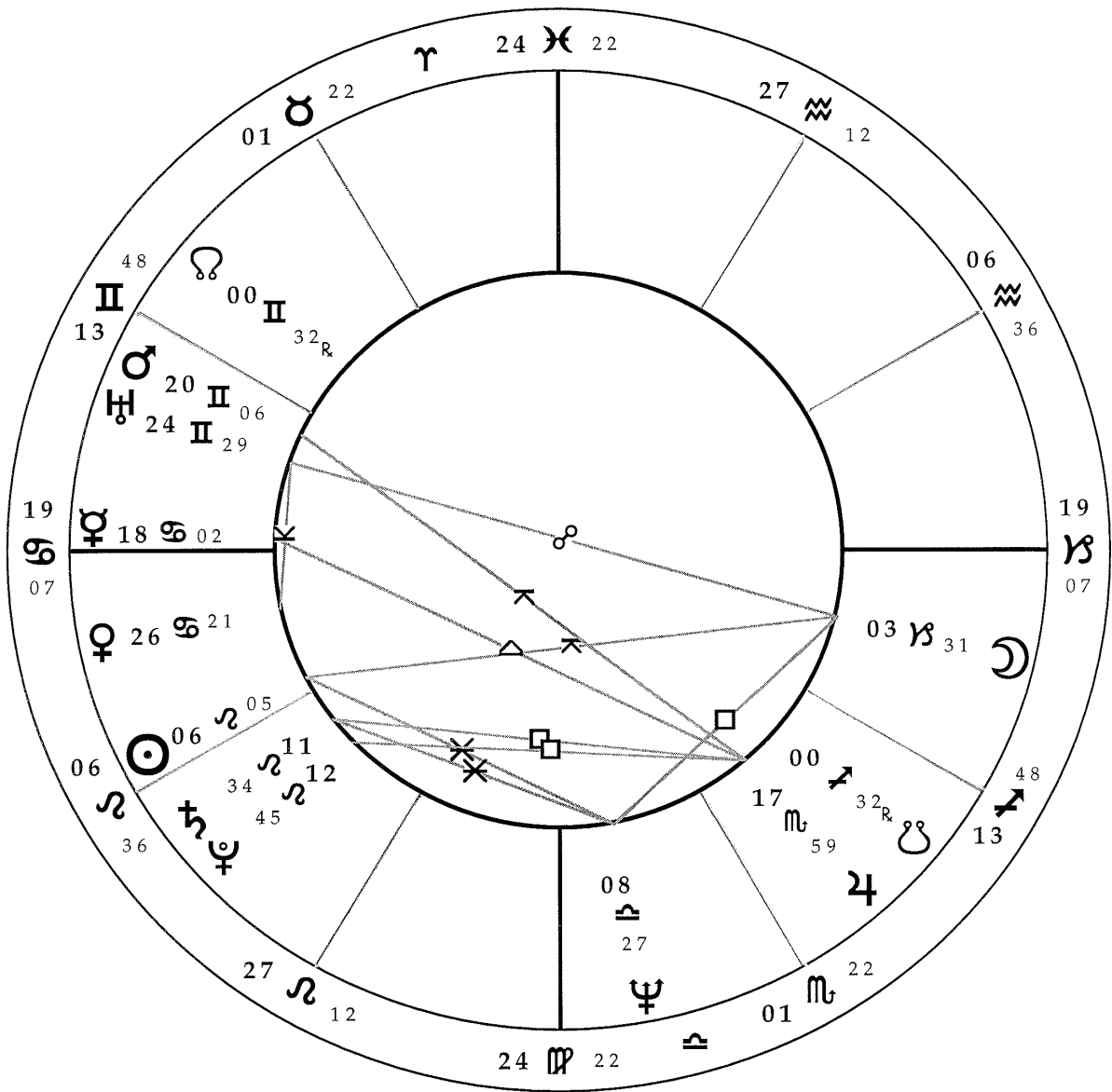
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
